- 1. Animals that cause injury to guests Remember, Missouri is a strict liability state and there are no "free bites."
- 2. Pools These are an "attractive nuisance" and an owner must take precaution that guests are not injured enjoying a swimming pool.
- 3. Trampolines Another "attractive nuisance" which can injure or kill young users. Make sure to warn guests of the hazards associated with using your trampoline.
- 4. Poorly maintained decks Rotten wood or unsafe railing can result in falls. You have a duty to make sure your decks are safe when guests are present.
- 5. Uneven surfaces Raised gaps in the joints between sidewalk concrete slabs can create a tripping hazard, resulting in fractures and knee injuries.
- 6. Poor lighting conditions Inadequate lighting in stairwells can create a dangerous condition, resulting in falls.
- 7. Snow and Ice You may have no duty to remove naturally accumulating snow and ice, but if an owner does make an effort to remove either, they must do a good job.
